A Very Happy New Year to You all!

What about a New Year's Resolution for the Clonenagh Group of Parishes? Read on...

Can we say 'yes' to any of the following questions?:

- We want our parish to be more welcoming of all people and to be filled with the voices of children and youth.
- People are moving in to our area and we want to help our congregation to reach them.
- Many of our members are overstretched and we have trouble finding enough people to help.
- We long to see people of all ages, children, teenagers and adults develop in faith, service and in the use of their God given gifts.

- We want to see our parish making a greater impact on our community.

I think we can say 'yes' to all those statements, don't you? But where do we start to make these changes?

In the rapidly changing face of Ireland, churches are facing change like they have never faced it before. Many of us within the Church recognise the need for change, but we also recognise that it takes energy and resources to do so. Often all our energy is used up on keeping the show in the road, or maintenance religion. The will to change is there, but the enthusiasm is lacking. We're also afraid that we don't have the resources to bring things forward.

At the invitation of the Standing Committee, the Parish Development Working Group has devised a programme that it believes will be of real help to parishes that want to do more than simply 'hang on in there'. It's called '**Church 21**' and it's a programme of Parish Development that I believe will be of great benefit to our group of parishes.

The good news is, that from our diocese, we are one of four groups of parishes 'in the hat' to be considered for participation in the Church 21 programme. Each diocese in the country gets to have two groups take part, so lets hope that we are one of the two that will get to take part from the combined diocese of Cashel, Ossory, Waterford, Ferns, Lismore and Leighlin.

What do you say that we join them and have some of the verses written by members of our congregation?




