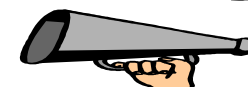

Table Tennis Round Up

Amylou Hayes continued her amazing run of form on Saturday December 6th at the prestigious Leinster Table Tennis Championships held in the IWA Centre, Clontarf, Dublin.

Carving her way through the U12 field of highly talented young players, the Mountrath girl set her sights early on at repeating a performance that saw her win this event last time around. Since that event however, a number of her opponents have acquired much top level coaching in pursuit of overtaking the Laois player. On this occasion, she set the day rolling with a number of comfortable victories leading to the semi finals. Here she was met with a strong challenge from Cristina O'Neill.

The York Road player went into an early lead and it took the second set for Amylou to get to grips with her, but from there on she remained in control and went on to win 3-1. In the final she met the current Irish number One, Meadbeth Slattery of Ballgriffin. A more difficult opponent could be hard to find as she plays with a strong pimped rubber on the backhand and a fast forehand offensive, combined with consistency technique placement and accuracy of an excellent standard made her an exceptional challenge.

The match got off to a slow pace of push chop and spin with neither player taking great overall risk. Slattery eventually gained control and took set one 11-9, set two saw the game even with Hayes turning the table at 11-9. Set three Slattery won 12-10 and set four Hayes took 11-8. All hung on the last set and a great silence took place for this as the points stood at 10-10. At this stage the Mountrath player dug deep into her tactics and placement ability and held her nerve to win 13-11. A great result, which has brought her to the top of Irish junior table tennis.

At the same event her sister Katie (U10) finished 3rd and another sister Linda (U14) reached the plate final. Keith Thompson (U17) and Jessie Hayes (U10) also of Mountrath TTC continue to make good progress in top level competition.
