### Rector's Notes

#### Gift Days - St Bridget's Weekend

Due to the ongoing tragedy of war in the Gaza Strip at this moment, Clonenagh Group of Parishes is having two **Gift Services in aid of the Al Ahli Arab (Anglican) Hospital** in the Gaza Strip. This hospital is in desperate need of medical supplies, food and warm clothing. Yes, what we gather may only be a drop in the ocean to what is needed, but as Archbishop Tutu says, the ocean is made up of many drops, so let's get started on that ocean! If you want to help put this hospital and its wonderful staff in a position to perform as a hospital should at this terrible time, please put what you can in a sealed envelope and bring it along to which ever of the two Gift Services is handy for you.

The first Gift Service will be on **Saturday the 31<sup>st</sup> of January at 8p.m., in St Mark's Church in Borris-in-Ossory.** The second one will be on **Sunday the 1<sup>st</sup> of February at 11.30a.m. in St Peter's Church in Mountrath.**

Your donations will be channelled to the Al Ahli Arab (Anglican) Hospital through Bishop's Appeal.

The speaker at the two services will be **Dr Susan Hood.** Dr Hood coordinated the visit of the Irish Church leaders on their visit of hope for peace

to Israel/Palestine, 2008, and is involved in several peace programs involving faith communities in the region, including *Youth Connections for Peace* which aims to connect young people in Ireland, Palestine and Israel through dialogue, confidence-building and activities.

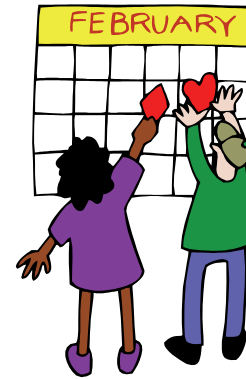
