In 1918, the ringing of bells was used to spread news of the end of the conflict that had engulfed the world in four terrible years of warfare. Now for the Great War's centenary they are being used again. On 11 November 2018, 100 years since Armistice, bells will ring out in unison from churches and cathedrals in villages, towns and cities across Europe. The bells in our churches will sound to mark 100 years since "the war to end all wars" ended, and to remember our honoured dead. It is poignant too that Germany's church bells also will ring out this day, together with our own, at 11am.
