

Confirmation 2019: If you have a son or daughter who would like to be confirmed in 2019 please contact the Rector. So far we have around six young people who have expressed an interest in being Confirmed this coming May. Classes begin at 3pm on Sunday 3 March in St. Peter's Church, Mountrath. The confirmation service itself will take place in Annatrim Church on Sunday 12 May 2019.

Rector's Course Days: The Rector will be undertaking a Team Leadership course in St. Luke's Pastoral Education Centre, Northridge, Co. Cork, beginning Wednesday 27 February and running for five full Wednesdays before Easter. This will necessitate changes to the Home Communion rota in March, but the Rector will be in touch with those on the list to reschedule. It also means that with the exception of Ash Wednesday, our parish Lenten services will take place on Tuesday evenings for March and April.
