The Rector Writes

Ash Wednesday 2022

Ash Wednesday is the first day of the forty days of Lent, a six-week period dedicated to prayer and reflection reminding us of Jesus' forty days in the desert, and is a time of preparation for the momentous celebration of Our Saviour's Resurrection on Easter Day. The late Roman Catholic cleric Henri Nouwen once described Lent as "A time to re-focus and to reenter a place of truth. It is here where we find our true identity."

Our Group celebration of Holy Communion on Ash Wednesday is a wonderful way to begin our parish services for Lent because we are embarking on a season which calls us into selfexamination as well as into deeper contemplation about the mystery and grace of God's mercy. The ancient practice of Ash Wednesday — sackcloth, ashes and prayerful penitence - reminds us that we are all mere imperfect, mortal, human beings. It helps us to pause and look at our lives: to remember what we are made of, to remember where we are going, and it encourages us to fully immerse ourselves in Christ.
