## The Rector Writes

#### The Beloved Disciple

Now our Lenten journey is almost at an end, our churches - spartan for Lent - are now brimming and beautifully decorated with flowers and the Gloria, left unsaid and unsung for forty days, now returns to our liturgies. Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

Our Easter Gospel lists three significant persons: Mary Magdalene, Peter and the Beloved Disciple - the 'disciple whom Jesus loved' (John 21:7, NIV). He is not named, and so this disciple is in fact all of us. each and every one of us are the Beloved Disciple. The ever-faithful Mary, loyal to the end, goes to the tomb despite the dangers involved, and even though it is dark she sees the stone has been moved. Immediately she runs and tells the others what she seen has and experienced: the empty tomb, Jesus' burial cloths, and the head-covering placed elsewhere in the tomb. Having heard Mary's account, the others also go to the tomb. They too see, but they more than just see. They see and believe. They see and believe with their hearts. God enables us to see the wonderful mystery of the resurrection because he gives us the eyes of faith.

This Easter, together with our brother and sister Christians across the world, let us follow the Beloved Disciple and Mary's example: let us too stand at the empty tomb and believe! Then have the courage to proclaim to all the good news of the resurrection. This Easter, may what we believe in our hearts, and profess with our lips... Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!
