

## The Rector Writes

## **Congratulations Canon Victor**

Thank you very much to so many of you for your good will, and kind words congratulating me on being appointed as an honorary Canon of St Canice's Cathedral, Kilkenny. Canons are appointed in recognition of their service to the Diocese, and it has come as a wonderful joy and a tremendous honour to me to take up the vacant prebendal stall of Killamery.

I joined Cashel, Ferns & Ossory Diocese in 2013 when I became rector of Kilcooley, and I'm now in my tenth year of ministry in the diocese, having become rector of Clonenagh in 2018. It is an immense joy to minister in this diocese – the clergy are tremendously collegial and congenial; the people are enormously supportive and encouraging; and both Bishop Michael Burrows and his successor Bishop Adrian Wilkinson have been an immense source of gentleness, understanding and compassion.

St Nicholas's Church, Killamery, was built in 1815 and was a place of worship for almost a century in our diocese. It remains standing today as a reminder that nothing stays still: transformation and change are facts of life.

Things change, people come and go, but our faith in Jesus Christ remains rock-solid throughout the ages, and although everything around us may change "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." (*Hebrews 13:8*).

Thank you all for the marvellous support you have shown to my mum, Pauline, and I since arriving in Clonenagh and God grant us our health to see through many, many more years of ministry here; and so I finish with, "To Him be the glory to all generations forever and ever." (*Ephesians 3:21*). God bless us all, this day and always. Amen.
